



**Dear President McCormick:**

In 1994, Coca-Cola gained exclusive “pouring rights” for all three Rutgers campuses — Newark, New Brunswick and Camden. Since then, Rutgers has supported Coca-Cola in spite of the company’s constant human rights violations in Colombia. Coca-Cola has not only turned a blind eye to paramilitary terrorists who murder, torture and kidnap leaders and members of the SINALTRAINAL union at Coca-Cola bottling plants in Colombia, but has actually collaborated with the paramilitaries in attempts to crush the union.

As Rutgers students, we are concerned for the safety of Coca-Cola workers and their families. We believe Rutgers should do everything possible to ensure that our University does not support a company that profits from murder and torture. **As students of this fine University, we deserve both a choice of beverages and a voice in determining whether our money ends up in the hands of a callous and criminally liable corporation.** Rutgers’ 10-year contract with Coke expires on July 31. It is our strong belief that this contract should not be renewed. Our beverage needs can be satisfied elsewhere without supporting a company that tolerates such gross human rights violations.
